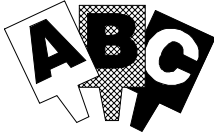

Once the Roster sheet is turned in, no seating changes may be made during Multiple Choice except during the official Substitution time. Substitutions may be done only at the midway point of multiple choice paddles. All team members participate in Team Written.

T&T Bible Quizzing Guidelines

➤ Guidelines

- Questions will only be asked one time, unless the Quiz Master deems necessary to ask the question a second time.
- Team Huddle is now called Team Written.
- No recording of questions is allowed. No writing them down, no video recording of them. (Video taping is only allowed the first five minutes and then the announcement will be made to turn off all video equipment.)
- A *Parental Consent and Release of Liability Form* must be filled out and turned in for each student participating in Bible Quiz.

➤ Quizzing Formats

- *Multiple Choice* will have ten questions. Each question is worth 10 points. Ultimate Adventure Books 1 and 2 will be Individual Quizzing format. Ultimate Challenge Books 1 and 2 will be Team Quizzing format.
- *Team Written* is 15 questions with up to 4 participants. Each question is worth 20 points for a correct answer; incorrect answers will have a 10 point deduction. There will be no penalty for an answer without any response.

➤ Bible Quizzing is divided into **four divisions**:

- Ultimate Adventure Book 1
- Ultimate Adventure Book 2
- Ultimate Challenge Book 1
- Ultimate Challenge Book 2

A clubber cannot quiz in the same book more than one year.

A maximum of 4 clubbers per team is allowed.

- Teams may be girls only, boys only or Co-ed. This option is the church's decision. A Girls only team must have only a female coach and a Boys only team must have only a male coach. Co-ed teams may have either a male or female coach. A minimum of 1 Coach per Division is required if teams are Co-ed. A minimum of 2 Coaches per Division is required if teams are not Co-ed.
- **Required Dress Code:** Awana emphasizes the importance of modesty, neatness and cleanliness in the apparel worn by both leaders and clubbers of all ages. All participants (including leaders and coaches) must wear an official Awana uniform.
- Teams need to arrive and register between 9:00 AM – 9:30 AM. A Coaches & Scorekeepers meeting will begin at approximately 9:30 AM. Quizzing begins at 10:00 AM.
- We will be quizzing from **Ultimate Adventure Book 1** (Start Zone & Discoveries 1-4), **Ultimate Adventure Book 2** (Discoveries 1-4), **Ultimate Challenge Book 1** (Challenges 1-4) and **Ultimate Challenge Book 2** (Challenges 1-4). *Ultimate Adventure Book 1* and *Ultimate Challenge Book 1* are the only books that will include the Start Zone. Quiz Questions may include the following types, but are not limited to: Questions & Answers, A Clue 4 U, Brain Check, Search Site, and Word Wise. Questions will not be taken from Just 4 Fun, review of questions and answers from a previous book or Silver and Gold extra credit sections.
- Substitutions may be made at the halfway point of the Multiple Choice round. No time-outs will be allowed with the exception of the Quizmaster's discretion.
- Each church must provide at least two volunteers. Additional volunteer staff will be needed if a church has more than 4 teams.
- **Awards**
 - *First place team*-medallions for each team member and a church plaque
 - *Second, Third & Fourth place*-ribbons for each team member
 - Each team member receives a participation patch (*Book One* = Red Patch, *Book Two* = Blue Patch, *Book Three* = Green Patch and *Book Four* = Yellow Patch)

Preparations of Bible Quizzers by Coaches

Emphasize the value and purpose of quizzing with the clubbers and get them excited!

- Quizzing will train them to know thoroughly what they have already learned.
- Quizzing will train them to serve the Lord by helping them to personally apply God's Word to their lives.
 - They can learn just to please Him, not thinking of rewards. Col. 3:23,24
 - They can learn from God special lessons. Col. 3:12
 - They can learn to be sweetly submissive to authority. Rom. 13:1,2; Titus 3:1-2
 - They can learn proper attitudes. Heb. 4:12
- The Bible Quiz will provide a wonderful opportunity to pray for each other and to see the Lord answer.
- Emphasize to alternates that they should pray much for the regular team members and vice-versa.

Involve the Parents

- Explain the Bible Quiz format and rules briefly to them after their child has been chosen as a Bible Quiz team member. Be sure to give the potential team members this information.
- Ask one or both parents to be at the Bible Quiz practice(s) whenever possible.
- Encourage parents to review with their child regularly and consistently at home. What is done at home usually determines how well prepared they feel for the Bible Quiz.
- Encourage parents to attend the Bible Quiz and give you any suggestions they might have on the Bible Quiz ministry.

Make up questions for your team members. Involve others to help you in this

- Questions asking the reference only
 - Quoting a verse after the reference is given
 - Giving the reference and quoting the verse after a partial verse (a phrase) has been given (Beginning phrase, middle phrase, concluding phrase)
 - Questions regarding the subject matter of a verse or Bible reading sections; Use exact questions in the manual or near exact
 - Miscellaneous such as rules for Christian growth, etc
 - Word meanings in each verse
 - Life situation questions asking what verse would be the answer or that they could use
- NOTE:* In all questions, be specific as to the book or verse desired since other correct answers could be given using a different verse than what you want as your answer.

Other Suggestions

- Have an objective standard to use in choosing your team
 - Progress in their handbook, but accuracy in their recitation
 - Knowledge & accuracy in giving answers during competition; Large Group Time & Quiz practices
 - Proper attitudes shown towards other teammates and those in authority
- If you have sufficient clubbers, consider having 4 clubbers or more in competition from each club.
- Be sure to reward with something very special those trying to make the Bible Quiz team & those who do not. Their time spent in Scripture will not be wasted.
- Use quizzing beginning in early fall periodically during Large Group Time to prepare & excite the clubbers for the Bible Quiz. Begin with easy questions.
 - Have the game teams compete against each other
 - Have clubs compete against clubs
 - Have your church club compete with other clubs of the same age from another church
